

WINDSOR LAKE

The District of Windsor Lake shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador bounded as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centre line of Torbay Road and the centre line of MacDonald Drive;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the centre line of MacDonald Drive to its intersection with the centre line of Prince Philip Drive;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the centre line of Prince Philip Drive to its intersection with the centre line of Allandale Road;

Thence running in a general northerly and westerly direction along the centre line of Allandale Road to its intersection with the centre line of the Trans-Canada Highway, also known as the Outer Ring Road;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the centre line of the Trans-Canada Highway to its intersection with the centre line of Thorburn Road;

Thence running in a general northwesterly direction along the centre line of Thorburn Road to its intersection with the City of St. John's Municipal Boundary (1998);

Thence running in a general westerly, northeasterly and southeasterly direction along the said Municipal Boundary to its intersection with the centre line of Logy Bay Road;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the centre line of Logy Bay Road to its intersection with the centre line of the Trans-Canada Highway, also known as the Outer Ring Road;

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the centre line of the Trans-Canada Highway to its intersection with the centre line of Torbay Road;

Thence running in a general southeasterly direction along the centre line of Torbay Road to the point of beginning.

Note: This District includes part of the City of St. John's.
